Notice for Sacred Heart Parish-Mound City KS

With deep sorrow for the suffering of victims and survivors of abuse, I share the sad news that that a former priest Robert Aiduk, has been added to the Archdiocese list of clerics who have had substantiated allegations of sexual abuse of a minor. Mr. Aiduk served in ministry here from September 1963 - September 1967 and the allegations investigated by the Archdiocese stem from his time at this parish. Mr. Aiduk left the priesthood in September 1967, and was subsequently voluntarily laicized in 2016. This news may cause a range of emotions, and I want to assure this community of the Archdiocese's commitment to all who have been harmed by an agent of the Church, to atone for the harm and to accompany survivors using restorative processes as they work toward healing and peace.
