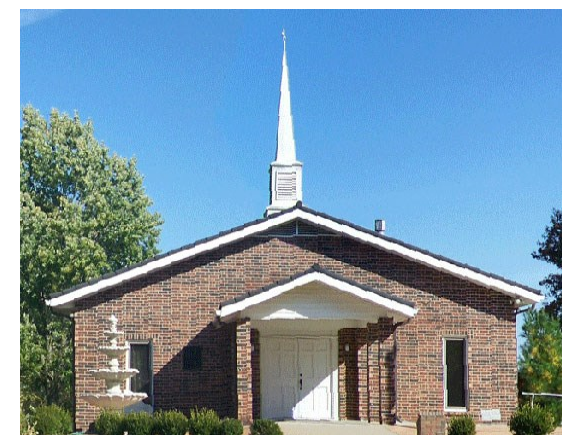

If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse may have occurred — call the archdiocesan confidential report line at (913) 647-3051 or the victim Care Advocate at (913) 298-9244, after calling local law enforcement. You can also make a report using the online form at: www.archkck.org/reportabuse. The Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas places the protection of children as its priority. The archdiocese respects the sincere concerns of all individuals who report misconduct and is committed to conducting thorough investigations of all allegations.
