Bioethic Issues Of Covid-19 With Rev. Tadeusz Pacholczyk
 Come to a captivating presentation tackling the Bioscience & Bioethics of vaccines, ventilators, and other ethical challenges of Covid-19 : 7 p.m., Sunday, October 18 at Holy Angels Catholic Church, Baseshor Kansas. The Rev. Tadeusz Pacholczyk, Ph.D., Director of Education at The National Catholic Bioethics Center in Philadelphia and the Center's National Catholic Certification Program in Health Care Ethics, will look at the phenomenon of the COVID-19 pandemic, and discuss its causes, the way it spreads, and the implications for certain ethical questions that arise as we seek to respond appropriately to the crisis. He will look at the question of allocating limited resources like ventilators, and discuss various aspects related to vaccinations, including the concerns about vaccines that are manufactured by reliance on cells derived from direct abortions, and questions relating to vaccine mandates.
