**“PLANNED GIVING BRIEF: END OF THE YEAR TAX PLANNING”**  
 Planned Giving Brief: End of the Year Tax Planning Congress enacted two tax provisions to encourage charitable donations before the end of 2020. These include:

1. Increase in tax deduction for cash gifts: For donors that itemize their tax return, before the new legislation, the annual income limit was capped at 60% for cash gifts. The new legislation allows for charitable donations up to 100% of a donor's annual income.
2. New deduction: If you do not itemize when filing your tax return, to reduce your tax liability, you will be allowed to take a special tax deduction of up to \$300 for charitable donations.

**Year of St. Joseph!**  
 Every so often the Church declares a year dedicated to a special focus. Recently, we have had the Year of Mercy, Year of Faith, Year of Priests, and Year of St. Paul. Now, on the 150th Anniversary of declaring St. Joseph Patron of the Universal Church, the Church has declared a Year of St. Joseph. Pope Pius IX made that patron declaration on Dec. 8th, 1870.  
 The Year of St. Joseph will go from Dec. 8th, 2020 to Dec. 8th, 2021!



**The Meaning of Advent Candles**  
 As a Christian tradition, the wreath holds the four Advent candles. The candles represent Jesus coming as the light in darkness. One candle is lit each Sunday until all four candles are lit, and sometimes a fifth candle is lit on Christmas. As Christmas draws nearer, each candle brings a little more light into the darkness.

**Each of the candles represents an aspect of preparation during the season of Advent:**

**The Candle of Hope**  
 Color: Purple  
 Purple is the primary color associated with Advent. Within the Catholic Church it symbolizes penance, preparation, and sacrifice. During the first week of Advent, we look forward to Jesus' coming with hope.

**The Candle of Peace**  
 Color: Purple  
 During this second week of Advent, we reflect on our lives and work on becoming better-versions-of-ourselves in preparation for Jesus' coming.

**The Candle of Joy**  
 Color: Rose  
 This third candle is rose, symbolizing anticipation and rejoicing. During the third week of Advent, we are filled with joy for the near arrival of Jesus on Christmas day.

**The Candle of Love**  
 Color: Purple  
 During this final week of Advent we rejoice in the endless love that God has for us, which is made apparent in the birth of his Son:  
 "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."  
 - John 3:16
