The Secretariat for the Synod of Bishops has requested input from dioceses on two questions. Responses to the two questions will be synthesized into a short report to be submitted by each diocese to the U.S. bishops' synod team. Two listening sessions in the Archdiocese are scheduled to receive input: March 19 at Church of the Nativity Parish Hall, Leawood, and March 20 at Most Pure Heart of Mary Parish Hall, Topeka. Registration is not necessary. 6:30pm-8pm. The two questions being considered exclusively are: 1) Where have I seen or experienced the church's structure(s), organization, leadership or life facilitate or hinder the church's mission of spreading the Good News of Jesus Christ? and 2) How can the structures and organization of the Church help all Christians respond to Christ's call to proclaim the Gospel and to live as a community of his love and mercy?
