Prayer request to St. Joseph, Defender of Life

On 3/26, the U.S. Supreme Court heard oral arguments in a case that has the potential to make a major impact in the widespread accessibility of chemical abortion (abortion pills), now the most common form of abortion in the United States. The case will consider whether the Food and Drug Administration's (FDA) can continue violating federal law by promoting the availability of chemical abortion while ignoring risks to women. In short, the FDA has enabled a nationwide mail-order abortion industry and turned neighborhood pharmacies into chemical abortion providers. While this case is not about ending chemical abortion, it can restore limitations in federal law that the FDA has overridden. The decision is expected to be released sometime in June. Please join a focused effort of prayer for the end of abortion and the protection of women and preborn children.

As God's humble servant, you guided the Holy Family on the road to Bethlehem, welcomed Jesus as your own son in the shelter of a manger, and fled far from your homeland for the safety of both Mother and Child.
