To obtain the plenary indulgence any time during November, visit a Cemetery, pray for a deceased person (Eternal Rest Prayer), and receive Communion and sacramental Confession (and have no attachment to sin. even venial).

Communion is received each day we wish to gain the indulgence for a deceased person, but we only need to go to Confession once within about 20 days before or after the indulgences. And, as with all plenary indulgences, we must pray for the intentions of the Holy Father (one Our Father and one Hail Mary) each day we perform the work of the Indulgence.
