

Plenary Indulgence for deceased available Nov.1-8, Visit a Cemetery

To obtain the plenary indulgence any time from November 1-November 8, visit a Cemetery, pray for a deceased person (Eternal Rest Prayer), and receive Communion and sacramental Confession (and have no attachment to sin, even venial otherwise it is a partial indulgence).

Communion can be received each day we wish to gain the indulgence for a deceased person, but we only go to Confession once and that can be within 20 days before or after. And, as with all plenary indulgences, we pray for the intentions of the Holy Father (one Our Father and one Hail Mary) ideally each day we perform the work of the indulgence.
