The Meaning of Advent Candles

As a Christian tradition, the wreath holds the four Advent candle The candles represent Jesus coming as the light in darkness. On candle is lit each Sunday until all four candles are lit, and sometimes a fifth candle is lit on Christmas. As Christmas draw nearer, each candle brings a little more light into the darkness.

Each of the candles represents an aspect of preparation durin the season of Advent:

The Candle of Hope

Color: Purple

Purple is the primary color associated with Advent. Within the Catholic Church it symbolizes penance, preparation, and sacrific During the first week of Advent, we look forward to Jesus' comin with hope.

The Candle of Peace

Color: Purple

During this second week of Advent, we reflect on our lives and work on becoming better-versions-of-ourselves in preparation for Jesus' coming.

The Candle of Joy

Color: Rose

This third candle is rose, symbolizing anticipation and rejoicing During the third week of Advent, we are filled with joy for the ne arrival of Jesus on Christmas day.

The Candle of Love

Color: Purple

During this final week of Advent we rejoice in the endless love th God has for us, which is made apparent in the birth of his Son: "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, th whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." - John 3:16
