



Prayer Information

Prayer is essentially a conversation with God, speaking and listening. We know how to speak to God, but listening is a little more challenging. The St. Rose Duchesne Council 7446 K of C will hold its annual fish fry We listen primarily through the Word of God. Praying over Scripture to listen to God speak uniquely to us is called Lectio Divina. A method for Lectio Divina can be with the 4 R's.

Read - prayerfully and slowly go over scripture and perhaps a commentary on scripture as well, you can even repeat the reading several times seeing what stands out to you

Reflect - ponder on what stands out to you for a time

Relate - relate what stands out to you with God, conversing with Him about that

Resolution- make a concrete resolution such as calling to mind a word or phrase that day or carrying out some action that day, this way we are integrating our prayer in to our lives

What resources are there for prayer?

The Bible especially the Gospels and Psalms, Mass readings for the day a devotional that helps break open the Word such as Magnificat, Word Among Us, Daily Prayer 2019. A daily email meditation on the Gospel called Regnum Christi, apps such as Laudate, Relevant Radio app which has a podcast called in conversation with God, and EWTN app. Bishop Barron's Lent Reflections.com, Lent emails from dynamiccatholic.com. The Rosary and Mysteries of the Rosary are also a good source for meditation. The Divine Office is a good source of prayer as well and can be found on an app called iBreviary. For more on Lectio Divina go to Formed.org and listen to a talk on prayer called Lectio Divina.


