Pastor's note:

Prayer is really just talking with God. In prayer, we speak and listen to God. We speak to God with our concerns and thanks. We can also offer formal prayers like the Our Father and Hail Marys. We listen to God speak to us as we reflect on His Word or in a good Catholic spiritual book on Scripture and Faith. We can take that encouragement and help we receive with us through the day. Schedule in at least 10-15 minutes of quiet prayer with God each day. Here are some resources for your prayer: The Bible, a Catholic edition. The Gospels can especially be helpful as they are about Christ directly. Some devotionals can be helpful to break open the Word such as Word Among Us, Magnificat, or a series of books called In Conversation with God. Also, online you can sign up with Regnum Christi daily meditations to receive emails of the daily Gospel and reflections on that Gospel to apply to your life. Just as we talk with others to get to know them, let us talk with God in prayer to better get to know God and grow closer to God!
