As we begin back with Masses during the weekend and weekday, please know that you are welcome but do not have to come if you decide it would be best not to at this time. The obligation for Sunday/ Saturday eve Mass is still lifted by Archbishop until further notice. If you are at risk you may want to consider still staying at home. Those who are sick please do stay home as well as anyone exposed to the coronavirus recently. For those that come, please wear a mask (outdoor Mass perhaps not needed but still can do so). We will have some extra masks available if needed at Church. Please social distance from other households by staying 6 feet away at all times including going and coming, seating, and at Communion. If you would like to receive Communion, you can remove your mask while the person in front of you receives. Be careful not to touch the middle of the mask where germs can be. After you have received Communion you can step to the side and place your mask on and then return to your pew. People can go pew by pew in a single line for Communion. Please depart pew by pew starting from the back when leaving. The collection basket will be at the back that you can drop a donation in coming or going. Thank you for your support.
