

Religious Freedom Rally JUNE 30th.

The Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas Offices for Pro-Life and Social Justice are collaborating with Faithful Citizens and FIAT to host a Religious Freedom Rally on Sunday, June 30, at Ascension Catholic Church (127th Str in Overland Park). This event will conclude the U.S. Church's Religious Freedom Week promoted by the US bishops to bring people together to "pray reflect, and take action on religious liberty, both here in this country and abroad". Archbishop Naumann will celebrate the 11:45am Mass at Ascensic Church followed by a hotdog lunch in the Parish Hall or under "the big top!" The religious freedom rally will begin at 1:30 pm.
