# Pastor's note:

Greetings!, Just to give you an update regarding our guidelines: Masks are now optional (can choose not to wear or can choose to wear if you would like to) Missal books will be back in pews along with pew cards (don't have to use if prefer not) Social distancing precautions are still in place and other precautions until around June 22 or so.

The Archdiocese has sent new guidelines to the Parishes. In the guidelines we are told that we can go with the county guidelines in our respective county. The State phased plan was initially mandated, but has since become a recommendation. Authority was handed over to the counties. The counties of Linn and Miami have both said that they too are not making requirements at this time, but they are recommending we follow the state plan. The State plan, as of June 8th, is in phase 3 of the plan. According to Phase 3, masks are optional at this point. So, at this time, we will go ahead and make wearing of masks up to you to decide upon. Missal books and pew cards will be returned back to the pews at this time. Social distance and other precautions will remain in place. On June 22nd, the State plan is anticipated to move into the phase out portion of the plan in which precautions will be more minimal. At or around that time, I will update you on any further adjustments we may make in terms of returning back to more of a normal setting for Mass. It is my hope we can do so around this time to some degree while maintaining safety. Some precautions will probably continue.

Please know that the obligation for Sunday/Sat eve Mass is still lifted by the Archbishop. This will probably remain in place into the Fall. You are most welcome to come to Mass, but don't have to if you have concerns. If you are sick or have been exposed to COVID recently. please do stay home. Thank you for your patience during this time. God bless. Father Clavton
