Sponsored by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), this annual observance highlights the many spiritual, relational, and health benefits of Natural Family Planning. NFP respects God's design for marriage, strengthens communication between spouses, fosters openness to life, and helps women better understand their reproductive health. The week also commemorates the anniversary of Humanae vitae (July 25), St. Paul VI's encyclical on married love and responsible parenthood.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE HUMAN IN THE AGE OF AI?
A PRESENTATION BY MSGR. SWETLAND
All are welcome for an evening with Msgr. Stuart Swetland as he unpacks Pope Leo XIV’s landmark first encyclical, Magnifica Humanitas—On Safeguarding the Human Person in the Time of Artificial Intelligence. The presentation will take place in the St. Michael the Archangel church on August 10 from 7:00 - 8:30 p.m. Signed on May 15, 2026, this historic document calls the Church and all people of good will to engage the promises and dangers of artificial intelligence through the lens of Catholic social teaching and the dignity of the human person. Drawing on Scripture, the tradition of Pope Leo XIII’s Rerum Novarum, and the vision of the New Evangelization, Msgr. Swetland will guide us through the key themes of the encyclical and what they mean for our lives, our families, and our world. Msgr. Swetland is the president of Donnelly College and for over 20 years has presented and defended Catholic social teaching through various media outlets.
