

There will be some new faith opportunities offered this Fall so please consider that as we get back in to routines after the summer schedule. Project at Sacred Heart

A request was presented to me about updates to the flooring and pews in our Church. Of course, our Church is already beautiful, but this would be an opportunity to update a little bit to keep it going well in the future as the wonderful Shrine that it is and will continue to be. Two interior designers selected three options for us to consider for material to use to reupholster the pews. There was one that was really strongly recommended to fit best in our Church and a committee of parishioners agreed with this selection. The committee had representation from Knights, Altar Society, Finance Council, and the Parish in general. The color is tan/blue/dark blue. It seems to tie in with our stain glass windows about St. Rose and tie in with the chairs in the Sanctuary. In addition to this work, a request was made to me regarding the flooring and kneelers. At this same time, we will go ahead and extend the flooring that is in the entrance way all the way through the pew area of the Church. We won't have carpet, but will rather have this new type of flooring. It is vinyl so doesn't seem to be as slick as some other material might be. The kneelers will also have new covers that tie in with the pews. This can be done without us having to move out of the Church. We may just have to move or cancel a Wednesday Mass, but otherwise it doesn't seem to be real interfering with us. It will begin soon and it is my hope that it will add to the already existing beauty of this wonderful Church and Shrine. God bless, Father Clayton
